### TASTING NOTES

: lush & juicy

Aromas of ripe raspberries and blueberries, fresh florals, vanilla, and a touch of white pepper open in the glass. Reminiscent of the nose, the silky palate boasts lush flavors of tart blackberry and orange cherries with a delicate simplicity. Notes of spice linger on the juicy finish.

### WINEMAKER NOTES

Santa Barbara County enjoyed a mild growing season in 2021. With optimal temperatures from bud break to harvest and a lack of spring rain and wind, the fall yielded full clusters with a high juice to skin ratio. Free of heat spells and extreme weather, the slow and steady season allowed a lush and ripe palate to show through on our pinot noir.

### FOOD PAIRINGS

Lush and juicy, this pinot noir pairs wonderfully with various dishes such as a red cabbage and warm spinach salad, lentil soup with sausage, pan-roasted salmon with caramelized endive, or roasted pork tenderloin.
